ORDER ON PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
HABEAS CORPUS

On November 5, 2025, this court issued an Order to Show Cause on two claims in the above-captioned Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus: an equal protection claim alleging the discriminatory use of peremptory strikes in jury selection (Claim 1a), and a claim alleging the use of racially discriminatory language at trial in violation of subdivision (a)(2) of Penal Code Section 745, the California Racial Justice Act (“RJA”; Claim 1b).


In a letter to the court dated February 4, 2026, Respondent the Alameda County District Attorney, on behalf of the People of the State of California, conceded that Petitioner was entitled to relief on his RJA claim, and that the People were unable to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the use of racially discriminatory language at Petitioner’s trial did not contribute to the judgment against him. (See Pen. Code §745, subd. (k).) The People requested that the court vacate the conviction and sentence, find that it is legally invalid, and order new proceedings consistent with subdivision (a) of Section 745. Petitioner, in a filing dated February 5, concurs in substance with the Respondent’s position and recommended course of action.

Based upon the People's concession and request, and Petitioner's response, the court GRANTS Claim 1b of the Petition.<sup>1</sup> The court hereby VACATES Petitioner's conviction and sentence in case number H10662, finding that it is legally invalid. (Pen. Code §745, subd. (e)(2)(A).)

The court orders Petitioner to appear (by video; counsel to prepare an order; alternatively, counsel may waive Petitioner's appearance) at **9:00 a.m.**, on **February 19, 2026**, in **Department 13** of this court, for a status hearing. After this hearing, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation shall remand Petitioner into the custody of the Sheriff of Alameda County pending further proceedings. (Pen. Code §1493.) This order does not grant Petitioner's discharge or release. (Pen. Code §1506; *People v. Bilbrey* (2018) 25 Cal.App.5th 764.)

IT IS SO ORDERED.
