14 STAY OF EXECUTION

16 WHEREAS, on September 25, 2007, SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt
17 was found guilty of COUNT 1 – MURDER OF THE FIRST DEGREE WITH USE OF A
18 DEADLY WEAPON by a duly and legally impaneled jury of twelve persons; and

19 WHEREAS, on October 3, 2007, that same jury returned a verdict of death against
20 SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt as to COUNT 1 – MURDER OF THE
21 FIRST DEGREE WITH USE OF A DEADLY WEAPON; and

22 WHEREAS, on December 20, 2007, SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt
23 filed an appeal with the Supreme Court of the State of Nevada; and

24 WHEREAS, on January 20, 2012, the Nevada Supreme Court filed an ORDER
25 AFFIRMING IN PART, REVERSING IN PART AND REMANDING SCOTT RAYMOND
26 DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt's conviction for MURDER OF THE FIRST DEGREE WITH USE
27 OF A DEADLY WEAPON, wherein the Supreme Court of the State of Nevada remanded the
28 matter to the district court to strike the deadly weapon enhancement attendant to the murder

1 conviction, but affirmed the conviction of MURDER OF THE FIRST DEGREE as well as the
2 Jury's imposition of the Death Penalty, with an Amended Judgment of Conviction being filed
3 on June 4, 2012; and

4 WHEREAS, on June 4, 2012, the Court filed an Amended Judgment of Conviction
5 striking the deadly weapon enhancement attendant to COUNT 1 – MURDER OF THE FIRST
6 DEGREE; and

7 WHEREAS, on July 27, 2012, SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt filed
8 a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction); and

9 WHEREAS, on October 31, 2016, SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt
10 contacted this Court by letter and indicated a desire to cease habeas litigation, waive all post-
11 conviction and appellate remedies and submit to his sentence of death. SCOTT RAYMOND
12 DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt has consistently maintained this position; and

13 WHEREAS, out of an abundance of caution, this Court ordered a psychological
14 evaluation of SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt. Dr. Michael Krelstein
15 authored a report dated July 9, 2017, that concluded that SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka,
16 Chad Wyatt was competent to decide whether to cease habeas litigation, waive all post-
17 conviction and appellate remedies and submit to his sentence of death; and

18 WHEREAS, the parties agreed to stay the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus filed on
19 July 27, 2012, in order to facilitate imposition of sentence. The parties further agreed that
20 should the STATE OF NEVADA not be able to carry out SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka,
21 Chad Wyatt's execution that the stay be lifted and habeas litigation may proceed in the
22 ordinary course, meaning that SCOTT RAYMOND DOZIER, aka, Chad Wyatt will be in the
23 same procedural posture as he was before attempting to carry out the execution; and

24 WHEREAS, on November 27, 2017, this Court entered an order enjoining the use of a
25 paralytic drug in Dozier's execution; and

26 WHEREAS, on June 1, 2018, this Court entered an order vacating the order enjoining
27 the use of a paralytic drug in Dozier's execution; and

~~WHEREAS, Petitioner has now expressed a clear and unambiguous statement that he desires to pursue habeas relief instead of submitting to his sentence; and~~


